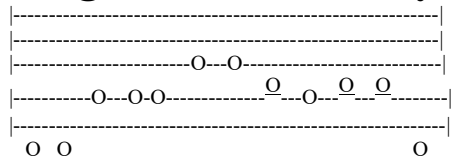


Song 408 - Ballad of Dynamic Measurement
