 That fear him.

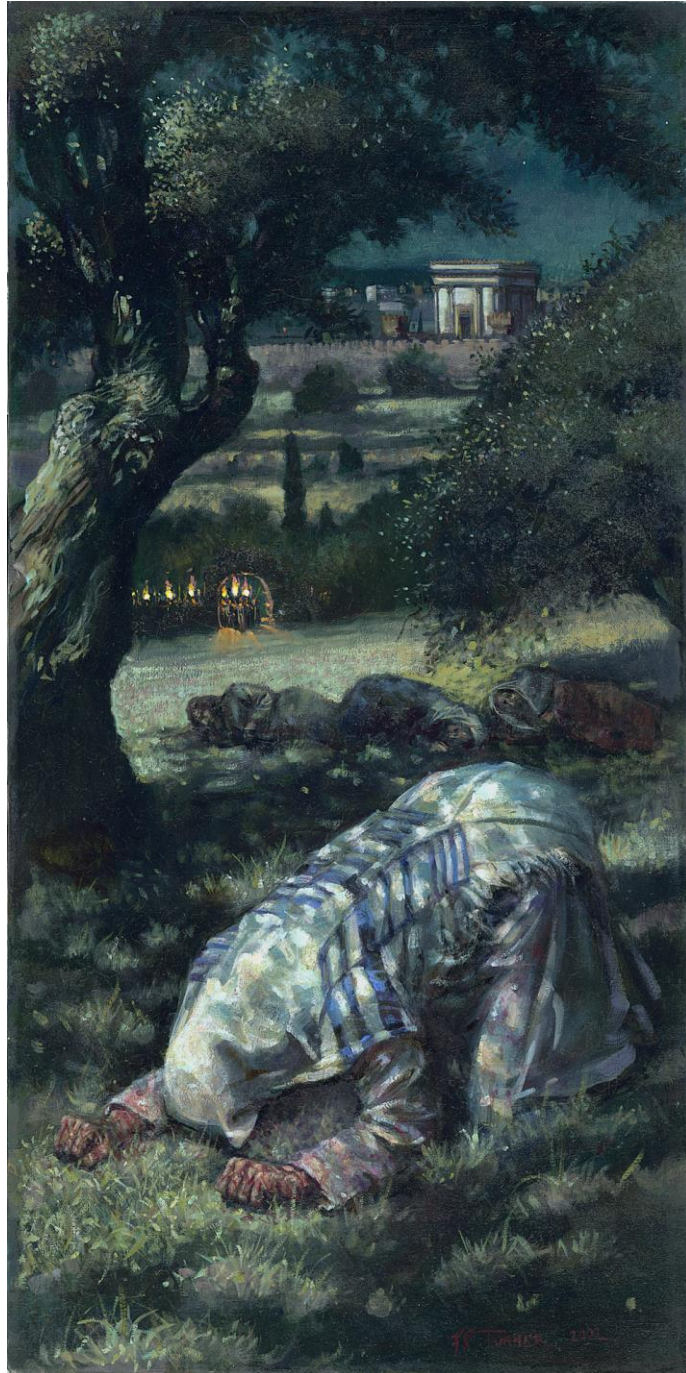
