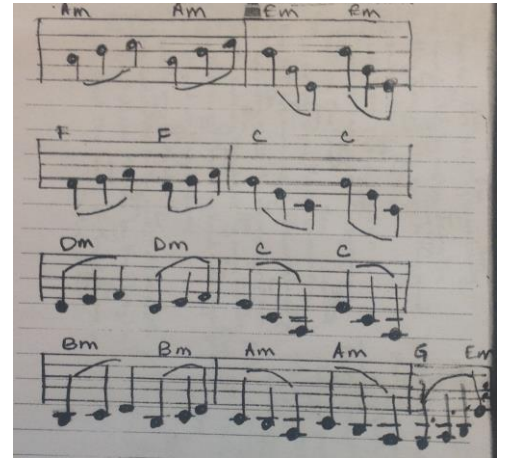

 Why doth thine anger smoke against the sheep of thy pasture?  
 C C Bm Bm  
 2. Remember thy congregation  
 Am Am G Em  
 Which thou hast purchased of old

----- Am Am Em Em  
 3. The rod of thine inheritance, which thou hast redeemed  
 F F C C  
 This mount Zion, wherein thou hast dwelt  
 Dm Dm C C  
 Lift up thy feet unto the perpetual desolations  
 Bm Bm Am Am G Em  
 Even all that the enemy hath done wickedly in the sanctuary

 4. Thine enemies roar in the midst of thy congregations  
 F F C C  
 They set up their ensigns for signs  
 Dm Dm C C Bm Bm  
 5. A man was famous according as he had lifted up axes upon the thick trees

 6. But now they break down the carved work thereof at once with axes and hammers
